## **Key Components of the Workshop:**

- 1. **Overcome common adaptive challenges** in the implementation of differentiated practice.
- 2. **Differentiate your coaching with six 'side-by side' formats** for working with colleagues in the classroom as you support teacher expertise within a gradual release model. See these coaching formats in action in video clips.
- 3. Use student-centered language in **constructive coaching conversations** that help guide teachers to **identify and maintain focus on the 'next step' for instructional innovation**.
- 4. **Acquire collaborative formats** for constructing profiles of students as readers and learners, and support teachers in using these as a road map for daily teaching.
- 5. **Align assessment data and instruction by co-planning** lessons and units of study with teacher teams and individuals.
- 6. **Establish a continuum of professional learning opportunities** on differentiated practice.
- 7. Compile a coach's toolkit that makes differentiation **doable for the classroom teacher**. Share these **menus of possible instructional responses** that address common sources of reading difficulties.
- 8. Examine how to target your coaching so that it results in lasting understanding and application in the classroom.
